What are CPT® II Codes?

CPT® II codes are supplemental tracking codes that can be used for performance measurement to help track the delivery of quality care. The codes also simplify how performance measures are reported and eliminate the need for chart abstraction. Eligible CPT® II Codes for the Incentive Program

Controlling High Blood Pressure (CBP) The percentage of members 18–85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension (HTN) and whose BP was adequately controlled (<140/90 mm Hg) during the measurement year. Note: BOTH the systolic and diastolic codes must be provided in the claim to receive the \$25 payment.	Systolic <140	3074F 3075F	\$25 per claim with BOTH the systolic and the diastolic codes

	Diastolic ≥ 90	3080F	Claims with only one code (systolic OR diastolic) will not receive the incentive payment.
Prenatal and Postpartum Care (PPC) The percentage of deliveries of live births on or between October 8 of the year prior to the measurement year and October 7 of the measurement year. For these women, the measure assesses the following facets of prenatal and postpartum care. • Timeliness of Prenatal Care: The percentage of deliveries that received a prenatal care visit in the first trimester, on or before the enrollment start date or within 42 days of enrollment in the organization. • Postpartum Care: The percentage of deliveries that had a postpartum visit on or between 7 and 84 days after delivery.
